DGMC Notes ... since May, 2009:

- ♪ We have added 18 new members to our roster; two are family memberships, two are student memberships and one is an organization.
- ♪ Our total membership right now stands at 96; some memberships include families of two or more persons.
- ♪ Our website has been up and running for quite some time; we were told recently that during 2010 we had 2824 "hits"; already in 2011, we have had 1635 hits. Check it out at www.dgmusicclub.org
- ♪ Our process for completion of our tax exempt status is in its final stages. Once the final "blessing" is sent by the federal government, our journey is complete. According to legal counsel, however, we are basically 501(c) (3) tax exempt as an organization. This means, of course, that tax exempt gifts may be given at any time to DGMC.
- ♪ The benefit recital, presented so beautifully by Chris Garafalo on March 19, raised \$925. This is almost twice the amount raised at last year's event.
