ANSWER (from *Fun Facts*, page 2)

The **curse of the ninth** is the superstition that a composer will die after writing his ninth symphony, but before he has an opportunity to complete his tenth. The most prominent examples are Ludwig van Beethoven, Louis Spohr, Franz Schubert, Antonin Dvorak, Ralph Vaughan Williams, Anton Bruckner and Gustav Mahler. Of course, there are many composers who did not succumb to this curse. Dmitri Shostakovich, who completed fifteen symphonies, is considered to have ended the curse.
