We would like extend our condolences to Joanne Bollinger, whose husband, Lowell, passed away on September 25th at the age of 91. Lowell attended and supported many DGMC events with Joanne, who was very active in our club until the Bollingers moved to Maine. Lowell's first wife, Peg, also had a long history with DGMC, having served as its president.

Lowell had a long, distinguished career at Argonne National Lab. He served as Director of the Physics Division for over 10 years. He was a pioneer of the ATLAS heavy-ion accelerator, which is one of Argonne's major user facilities and is still being used by scientists worldwide. Physics Di-

vision Director Robert Janssens states, "We owe it to Lowell's vision, persistence and leadership that ... resulted in the full ATLAS accelerator which was completed in 1985."
